Pastor Jeff Gauss from Epiphany Station (our supported church plant in Thief River Falls) will present the Bible Message, *The Making Of A Movement*, with text from I Thessalonians 1:2-10.

Epiphany Station is a new church in Thief River Falls, MN, affiliated with the Minnesota Baptist Conference. It began in a living room in the summer of 2006 as the dream of a few local laypeople who wanted to reach "outsiders" with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Last summer, with the prayers and financial support of Cross of Glory and several other churches, they were able to call Jeff Gauss as their full-time church planter pastor. God has richly blessed Epiphany Station in the past year with the average Sunday attendance growing from around 30 to 70 people, many of which have been un-churched or de-churched "outsiders." Several people have made first-time decisions for Jesus Christ and so far 6 adults have expressed a desire to be baptized this summer.

Epiphany Station is earning a good reputation in the community as a church that reaches beyond their walls to help make a difference in the community and as a place where imperfect people find love and acceptance. Our motto is simple: "Love God. Love People. Period." and enabled by the power of the Holy Spirit, that is exactly what we are doing.
